FEATURED SPEAKER: DR. FARHAN BHATTI

Farhan Bhatti is a Board Certified Family Physician who completed his residency in the Sparrow Family Medicine program in Lansing. He graduated from Lyman Briggs College with a degree in Physiology and also graduated MSU with a Political Science degree. He attended the College of Human Medicine at Michigan State University and practices in the Greater Lansing area.

Dr. Bhatti wrote in medical school that, "Family physicians are an underappreciated and undervalued breed. It is the family doctor who best understands the barriers to health and well-being that exist in communities and best knows how to overcome them. Family doctors have the privilege and good fortune to develop relationships with patients over time and watch them progress in their lives. There is a need for family physicians just about everywhere you look".

He has taken this philosophy into his professional practice. Dr. Bhatti is currently the Medical Director and CEO of Care Free Medical. Care Free Medical is a mid-Michigan nonprofit organization serving thousands of underinsured and uninsured patients without access to affordable healthcare in the Greater Lansing area. The belief is that every individual deserves access to quality, compassionate health and dental care, especially the most underserved in our community.
